.15 Profile Carrier

(Denver Rules) The intent of this event is to provide a Navy Carrier event which uses simpler, smaller, lighter and easier to build models as compared to the current AMA Profile Carrier aircraft. In pursuit of this goal, .15 Profile Carrier models are limited to moveable throttle, hook and elevator only. No moveable flaps, ailerons, leadouts, rudder, etc. are allowed. While there are no scale points awarded in this event, the model must have a military paint scheme and national markings. As a result of

the lack of scale bonus points, originality in model design is welcomed.

AMA Official Profile Navy Carrier rules apply except as follows: Engine:0.1525 cubic inch maximum displacement.
